

Resolution #3-2024 – Municipal Cooperation Resolution

Whereas, New York General Municipal Law, Article 5-G, Section 119-o (“Section 119-o”) empowers municipal corporations [defined in Article 5-G, Section 119-n to include school districts, boards of cooperative educational services, counties, cities, town and villages, and districts] to enter into, amend, cancel and terminate agreements for the performance among themselves (or one for the other) of their respective functions, powers and duties on a cooperative or contract basis; and

Whereas, the Village of Middleburgh Board of Trustees wishes to invest portions of its available investment funds in cooperation with other corporations and/or districts pursuant to the NYCLASS Municipal Cooperation Agreement Amended and Restated as of March 28, 2019;

Whereas, the Village of Middleburgh Board of Trustees wishes to assure the safety and liquidity needs of their funds.

Therefore, **Be it Resolved**, that Timothy Knight, Mayor of the Village of Middleburgh, is hereby authorized to participate in the NYCLASS program under the terms of the NYCLASS Municipal Agreement Amended and Restated as of March 28, 2019.
