CEMETERY RULES & REGULATIONS

ACTS PROHIBITED (Local Law No. 2 of 1993):

1. No person shall injure, remove, deface, or destroy any part of the cemetery or other property therein or post any object upon trees or any other related object in the cemetery.
2. No person shall build any fire in a cemetery except as is expressly authorized by the Village of Middleburgh.
3. No person shall throw, discharge, or drop any garbage, litter, refuse, sewage, waste or other offensive articles anywhere in the cemetery except in receptacles provided for such purpose. Where no receptacles are provided, all litter, garbage, refuse, waste, and offensive articles shall be carried away from the cemetery.
4. No person shall drive or propel along any road in the cemetery any vehicle at a rate of speed greater than fifteen (15) miles per hour.
5. No person shall conduct himself while in the cemetery in such a manner as to endanger the life, limb, property or morals of any other persons present.
6. **No person shall place or cause to be placed, without the written consent of the Village Board of the Village of Middleburgh, any permanent structures other than monuments or non-permanent markers (crosses, wreaths, solar lights, shepherd hooks etc.) or plant or cause to be planted, any tree, shrub, or other growing plant of any nature in any cemetery owned or operated by the Village of Middleburgh.**
7. No person shall be in the cemetery between the hours of 9:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. except with authorization of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Middleburgh.
